The *Club of the Year* Award recognizes a snowmobile club that demonstrates exceptional commitment to organized snowmobiling, active involvement with snowmobile organizations, and a dedication to making the sport enjoyable for members and the broader snowmobiling community.

The IASC winner is submitted to the ACSA competition for Snowmobile Club of the Year where Snowmobile clubs from all 27 snowmobile states are judged. The ACSA Club of the Year is announced at the annual International Snowmobile Congress held in June.

The IASC Club of the Year is featured in the the *Illinois Snowmobiler*. They will be invited guests to the annual IASC Convention Banquet in November, at which time they will receive a recognition award.
